I am a teacher in Turtle Tots and I am also the Forest School Lead.

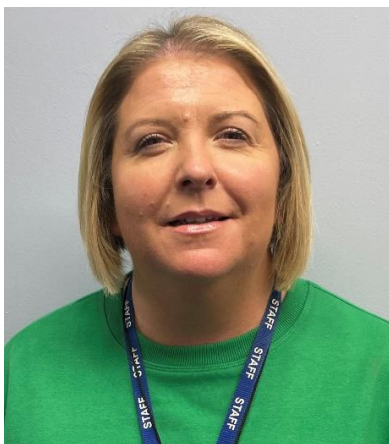
I like being outdoors and exploring the world around. I love spending time with my family and going on our adventures.

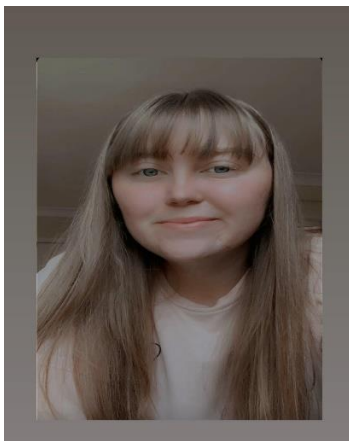

I work in the School office and am the SEND Administrator.

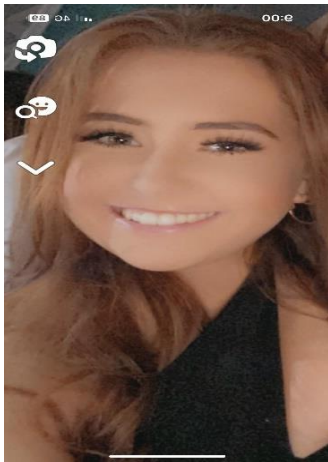
I love spending time with my family and going on long walks with my dog. I enjoy holidaying in the Lake District!
